Welcome! This year we celebrated the 80th Anniversary of this match. The **Merit Medals**, for the second year in a row, were again sponsored by the CMP (Civilian Marksmanship Program). Each competitor firing in the Sub-Junior and Junior portions of the match received a medal—Gold for Juniors & Silver for Sub-Juniors with a percentage noted on the back of the medal based on their fired score (100%, 99%, 98%, 97%, 96%, 95%, 90%, 80%, 70%, 60%, and 50%). One 100% percentage medal was awarded this year—Sub-Junior Match Winner Eric Sloan with a perfect score of 200.

A special addition to the match this year was an 80th Anniversary Logo Lunch Bag, donated by Pinpoint Promotions, which was given to each competitor. Pinpoint Promotions was also responsible for donating their time to update the artwork for this match. In an effort to encourage participation in the Senior Match, a “Lucky Draw” was added to the match this year.
